Update about our Weekly Groups

Young Leaders Course

A group of our Young Carers from the Thursday Youth Club have been taking part in an accredited Young Leaders Course. The course is being run in conjunction with Get Berkshire Active and the Community Youth Project.

The course provides numerous opportunities for positive assessment, which is used constructively and deliberately to build self-confidence, self-esteem and personal self-worth for young people. It improves skills in decision making, problem-solving, planning, assertiveness and self-control.



The participants are putting the skills that they learn on the course into practice in their day to day lives and then feeding this back to the rest of the group the following week.

One participant commented:-

"Since starting the course I am starting to see things in a different way and it is positively changing how I interact with my friends and Teachers"

After the Young Leaders Course is finished we will be going back to running the Thursday group as a youth club. This will be done virtually until the Covid restrictions are lifted and then will move back to the Greenham Community Centre.

Monday after School Group

New Group for Primary aged Children

After Covid restrictions are lifted we will be having two groups for the primary school aged Young Carers. The Thatcham Group will remain the same as before, this will be on a Monday, 4pm – 5.30pm at the Thatcham Family Hub. We will also be launching a new group at Greenham Community Centre in Newbury.

This group will be held on a Wednesday starting at 4pm and finishing at 5.30pm term time only. The decision to add this group was made so that more young carers from a wider area can take part in weekly sessions.

Challenge

We do not have official names for our Young Carers Groups. Thus far the two groups have been known as 'The Older Group' (secondary school aged) and 'The Younger Group' (primary school aged). We want to hear your suggestions for a new group name to be used instead.
